Complimentary Wi-Fi: "SHAW GO WIFI" FREE

The Shaw Centre is now offering a complimentary Wi-Fi service which is located on the 1st floor lobby directly in front of the administration offices. This is the only area of the building where this complimentary service is offered.

Individual On-site purchase:

Here are the instructions on how to purchase a wireless internet connection on-site at the Shaw Centre:

- Search the available wireless networks once you are in the Shaw Centre
- Connect to "SHAW GO WIFI" PAY AS YOU GO
- Open your preferred web browser (You will be automatically re-directed to a logon page)
- Select "Credit Card" as your method of payment in the drop down menu
- Enter the required information
- Select your preferred service package (\$10/3hrs, \$15/1 day, \$45/Event up to 5 days)
- Accept the terms and conditions and click "Continue"

Pre-paid individual access code:

For event organizers, a contract can put in place for pre-paid wireless internet access codes. Each unique device connecting to the Wi-Fi will require its own unique access code. Access codes are non-transferrable from one device to the other (I.E: Connecting 5 laptops will require 5 access codes). Based on the amount of access codes/connections you wish to purchase, a contract is sent in advance. Upon confirmation, you will receive your access codes along with the logon instructions. Purchasing pre-ordered access code will grant the attendee Wi-Fi access throughout the entire building including all pre-function & meeting spaces. The cost for individual access codes is \$20 per code per day
